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Updated ABP Program Guidebook - Comments + Clarity Needed

Nexamp has some clarifying questions and comments on the updated ABP guidebook:

- **On Page 37 – Designee Registration Section:** The new updates state that designees of Approved Vendors (third-parties) that have interaction with end-use customers must register. Nexamp only has *Marketing or Sales Designees*, and they are usually energy brokers who only market to commercial customers. **We'd like to understand from the IPA if individual energy brokers that are referring their existing commercial customers to Nexamp, but not actively soliciting new customers via outbound marketing have to register as our Designee ?**
- **Page 57-60 – Application Part Section:** The way this section is written seems directed at DG systems (i.e. rooftop systems installed for each customer). For example, it says the "disclosure form" is required for Part 1 applications occurring during the planning stage of an installation. But in our case, CS Subscribers' disclosure forms are submitted well after the planning stage, and instead much closer to the Part II application. **Our comment to the IPA here is to break this section into two parts, one for DG and the other for Community Solar.**
